Accept/Deny Changes to Ostrowski campground: New map. Many complaints. Will be total of 160 on each side of creek. Two access points. Overwhelming for a town our size. Can be seasonal sites. There would be water, power and septic. County holds public hearing for the people. Lake is getting busier. Concern of 4 wheelers abusing trails. \$320 total units would be developed in stages of 50-60 at a time. Would have 2 piers if that. WVIC will only allow limited piers. No boats to be docked or plan on boat access. Question on studies on impact of neighbor property values. How to keep people off land. Thinks land is wetland. Now people don't know property lines. There will be 50 ft green space. DNR involved in permits. Question on police presence. Discussion of seasonal sites 8 months. First step is board then CUP then state licensing. CUP helps property rights and has conditions. Carryover.
