Review proposed ordinance and fee discuss any changes for temporary rooming houses: WTA states need to justify cost. Worked off sample from WTA and Newbold. Oneida county just stamps applications and renewals. Would not apply to current in force rooming houses. \$100 is a justifiable fee.

Set date for public hearing for temporary rooming house ordinance: January 12th from 5:30 to 6:30.

Discuss wake boats on Lake Nokomis and ordinance: 34 emails expressing support 1 email opposing. Explanation as representative was not available. Send condition report to DNR. 3 weeks to get back. Public meeting with town of Bradley. Posted and in paper. Lake association and LNCC gets notices as well. 30 days after public meeting to approve then in paper. Looking to control wake boat activity not the boat. Enforcement is issue but it is stated with ordinance 99% typically comply. Enforcement would be DNR/ Person has concerns that not all information is being shared. People could argue that all boats can do the same damage. Would like to board to get more information. This would impact any water in Nokomis. Carryover
