Call meeting to order: Nate Gaedtke, Chairman, called meeting to order in accordance with the Open Meeting Law at 6:00 PM.

Approve agenda with agenda items being action items. .1 motion Bette, 2. motion Cheyenne. All in favor

Approve check and vouchers, May and June. Void checks 20632 reissued and 20554 returned: 1 motion Bette to void 20632 and 20554, 2. motion Cheyenne. All in favor

Approve May and June financial: \$2,099,156.61. 1 motion Cheyenne, 2 motion Bette. All in favor

Approve minutes from 6-8-26: 1 motion Bette, 2. motion Nate. All in favor

Fire department update: report read.

Cemetery updates and deeds: No deeds no update

Update on road construction and road issues: Hired employee start 7-20-26. Woodland Trail is done. County is aware of holes by Tilted Loon. Prairie Rapids culvert in August. Prairie Rapids to cemetery repair with Flexpatch. Opening door, \$7,600 for handicap accessible. Generator \$12,800 for the food pantry. Washout on Prairie on roads from rain.

Park updates: Little League done. They raised \$124 to go to the park, would like committee. Dave C would like to run to get more baseball use. Fertilize baseball field and spray playground. Topsoil not delivered for septic. Mary's Park fence repair needed.

County issues: 12-month moratorium for data centers. Livestock ordinance as well.

Accept/deny operator license: 1 motion Bette, 2 motion Cheyenne to accept operator license. All in favor

Update on Nokomis land use plan: Report read.

Discussion on room tax: Carryover no information from other townships. 1 motion Bette, 2 motion Cheyenne. All in favor

Update on proposed temporary rooming house ordinance fees: Carryover, need to decide on room tax. 1 motion Nate, 2 motion Bette. All in favor.

Update land division ordinance: meeting on July 27th at 6 p.m. at the town hall. Karl's the best contact from planning and zoning. Should look at adding data centers to ordinance.

Update on housing for Med-4: Wayne is the chair. Explanation of housing and building. Working with Keller & Associates and other options on addition versus other options available. Keller will help with process. No solid numbers.

Accept/deny wakeboard ordinance: Reviewed all information, statement read. No further discussion. 1 motion Cheyenne, 2 motion Nate to accept. All in favor.

Discuss, accept, deny moving forward with vacating a portion of Swamp Creek Road: Long, cumbersome process. Nate feels should be addressed at a later time. 1 motion Cheyenne, deny moving forward. 2 motion Nate. All in favor.

Accept/deny new alcohol beverage license, Swamp Lake Properties LLC: 1 motion Nate, 2 motion Bette. All in favor.

Accept/deny preliminary land division for Brian McCumber, Area A. Bringing to town first as preliminary. 1 motion Bette, 2 motion Cheyenne. All in favor, one opposed, Nate.

Discuss/accept/deny LaCane driveway permit. History of property. Denied because of driveway with requirements. Driveway currently has a 15-foot versus a 16-foot. Has existed 47 years. 15-foot has been access, not driveway. Not in favor of making exception on ordinances. 1 motion Nate to deny, 2 motion Cheyenne. All in favor.
